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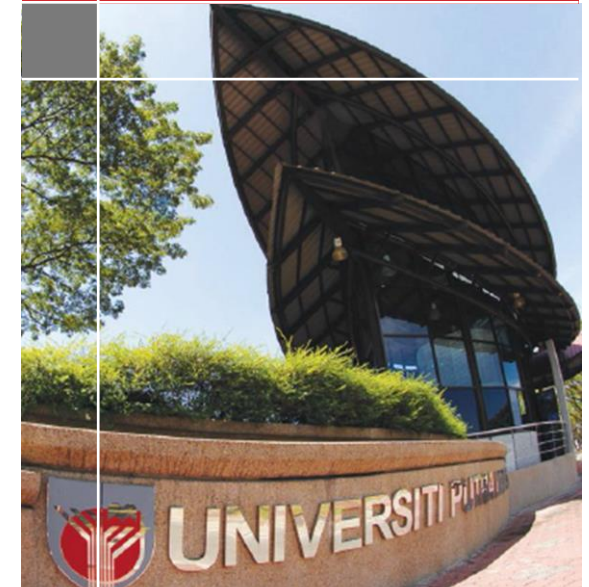

Outbound Mobility Programmes

Student Mobility Program (Outbound) provides opportunities for students to gain experience of UPM education by following any academic program offered at universities outside Malaysia.

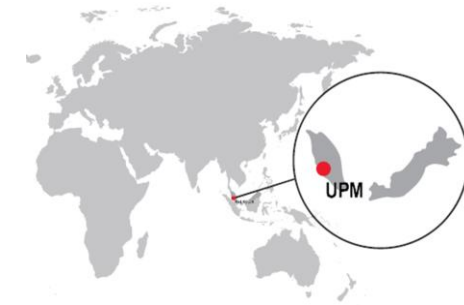
The objectives of Outbound Mobility:

- Expanding the educational experience for UPM students;
- Provide opportunities for UPM students to understand the field of endeavor;
- To enable UPM students to practice what they have learned and practiced;
- To train students as UPM ambassadors and Malaysia ;
- Gain knowledge and brighten UPM students to become competent graduates, the originator of science and scholarship catalyst respected.



Types of Outbound Mobility:

- Exchange programme (1 or 2 semesters)
- Short term programme (2 weeks or more)
- Internship (2 weeks to 6 months)
- Industrial Training (2 weeks or more)
- Research attachment (2 weeks or more)
- Visit (less than 2 weeks)



Students in FCSiT are encouraged to grab the chances to have additional educational experiences to enroll academic courses from outside universities!

Get Your International Experiences While Studying in FCSiT UPM

Program Requirements:

Student must have and fulfill the following requirements before applying the mobility programme:

- The program has academic elements and creditworthy;
- Getting the approval from the faculty;
- Undergraduate or postgraduate in UPM;
- Citizen of Malaysia;
- CGPA 3.0 and above.

How to Apply:

There are several steps the applicants must follow before can undergo the mobility programme. The steps are as below:

1. Get a place at institutions within or outside the country;
2. Request a letter of support from the faculty;
3. Request letter from the host institution;

4. Fill out the application form student mobility, credit transfer forms and insurance forms;
5. Submit the completed application (with required attachments) to the faculty;
6. Wait for the results of the Mobility Committee meeting, UPM.
